Stamen

Nectar-producing structure of the flower that attracts insects in to encourage pollination.

Filament

The organ that creates the seeds for the flowering plant.

Ovary

The part of a flower's Stamen which supports the anther, by holding it upright to make pollination easier when insects enter the flower.

Ovule

The pollen producing part of the flower, that is made up of an anther and a filament.

Nectary

Usually green and look like small leaves. They enclose and protect the flower bud as it grows into a flower.

Sepal

Is the enlarged portion at the base of the stigma where ovules are produced.
